other evidence being collected.

## OTHER SEARCH WARRANT INFORMATION:

Crime scene personnel cleared the scene at approximately 0740 hours. The cross-reference case number used by the Long Beach Police Department is #970042795. The evidence was packaged and checked into the Long Beach Police Evidence Section by myself later in the day of 05-29-97. A copy of the LBPD Search Warrant Property Report is attached. Photocopies of the probation paperwork, the handwritten note, the photograph, and the Primadonna flyer are attached.

## **VEHICLE #2 PROCESSING- FLEET SERVICES TOWING:**

On 05-29-97, I responded to the police towyard along with LBPD Homicide Detective Tim Cable. The towyard was located at 901 W. Anaheim Blvd. In Long Beach and we arrived at approximately 1540 hours. The vehicle was secured in a garage bay at the lot upon our arrival. Color photographic negatives were exposed to show the vehicle for identification, condition, interior, and location/overalls of recovered evidence. Several paper items and two black & white photographs were collected from the trunk, and impounded as evidence. The vehicle was made available to the owner upon our clearing this location, which was at approximately 1625 hours.

## ADDITIONAL FOLLOW-UP INVESTIGATION:

On 06-02-97, I responded to the Primadonna again, arriving at 0250 hours. Color photographic negatives were exposed to show the intact seals and lockout on the exterior of the women's bathroom door. Additional examination was conducted in the bathroom for the presence of footwear impressions in the toilet stall adjacent to the northeast handicapped stall. Results were negative. The door was relocked, resealed, and rephotographed prior to my clearing this location.

## **AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS:**

On 06-02-97, I responded to the Air Support Section of the department, arriving at 1045 hours. We flew to Primm, NV., where color photographic negatives were exposed of the exterior of the Primadonna Hotel/Casino, and to show the hotel's relationship to the adjacent Buffalo Bill's Hotel/Casino, and to the Whiskey Pete's Hotel/Casino, to the west of Interstate 15.
